The Chairman may associate any other person as expert on a particular subject matter under consideration of the Empowered Committee, if deemed necessary.

- 2. Powers and Functions:** - The Empowered Committee shall exercise the powers and perform the functions as mentioned below: -

- (a) to receive applications for clearances for setting up industrial undertakings alongwith the proposed amendments beyond the investment limit as may be notified by the State Government.;
- (b) to review and monitor the disposal of applications made to the District committee and the competent authorities;
- (c) to examine and review the orders passed by the competent authority, in accordance with the provisions of section 17 of the Punjab Industrial Facilitation Act, 2005.

Provided that where an order of clearance has been passed by the State Government as a competent authority, the same shall be referred to the State Board, for appropriate decision.

- (d) to grant exemption or relaxation to any existing or proposed industrial undertaking or category of industrial undertakings or cluster of undertakings from the operation of any of the provisions of this Act or rules made there-under;
 - (e) to grant exemption or relaxations from the provisions for any other State Law relating to industrial development under which an authority subordinate to the State Government has been empowered under the law to grant such exemption or relaxation; and
 - (f) to resolve inter-departmental matters pertaining to industrial undertakings.
3. The decision of the Empowered Committee shall be final and binding on the District Committee and the competent authorities and if there is any conflict between the decisions of the Empowered Committee, the District Committee, or the competent authority, the decision of Empowered Committee shall prevail.
4. The Committee will meet at least once in a month.
